Maire will sign copies of her well-known book on 'Clones Lace - the Story and Patterns of an Irish Crochet', which has been republished by Lacis this summer.

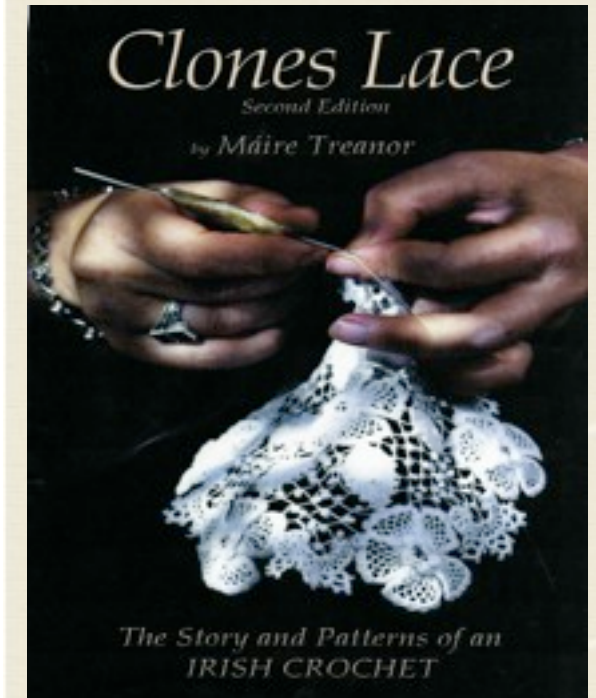


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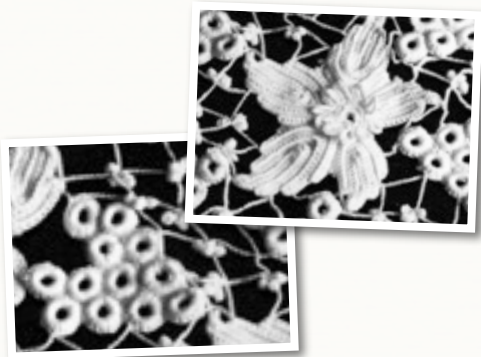
